The Adelphi Hotel back in Saratoga Springs

Following an extensive five-year renovation, The Adelphi Hotel in Saratoga Springs, New York, re-opened on 1 October. Adelphi Hospitality Group collaborated with New York-based architecture and design firm Glen & Company to reimagine the hotel's interiors, and Dominick Ranieri Architect P.C. was the leading architect for the hotel's structural transformation and restoration.

Originally opened in 1877, The Adelphi has been a cultural icon of upstate New York. Now the hotel has 32 guestrooms, a 2,300-square-foot grand ballroom opening to the gardens and several restaurant and bar spaces.

"The Adelphi Hotel dates back to Saratoga Springs' Victorian age when the town was known as America's playground for the rich and famous, and we are grateful to be part of such a culturally vibrant community," said Adelphi Hospitality Group Managing Partner Simon Milde in a news release.
