SARATOGA SPRINGS, N.Y. » The recently reopened historic Adelphi Hotel marked the official start of its new chapter with a ceremonial ribbon cutting on Thursday with members of the community.

The Adelphi Hotel's managing partner Simon Mildé said the 32-room landmark boutique hotel turned out better than expected.
